The Positive Action towards Career Engagement

(PACE) mentoring program connects jobseekers with disability, mental health conditions or chronic illness with a mentor from AKG or, one of our member organisations who has advice and wisdom to share.

During the 4-month program, the mentor and mentee will meet fortnightly to work on the mentee's career goals, resume writing, interview techniques, and confidence building.

The mentor will give advice and coaching on starting a career, understanding how a business work, discussing changes that might help mentee in the workplace and define their career path. According to our survey in 2020, out of the mentees that applied for a job throughout the course of the program, 70% were successful in their applications.

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Mentors reported a:

37% increase in their confidence to welcome an employee with disability into their team

35% increase in their awareness of the prevalence of disability in Australia

34% increase in their understanding of possible barriers experienced by people with disability

Mentors reported a:

50% increase in their confidence in sharing disability-related information with employers

48% increase in their awareness of different employment pathways available

46% increase in their confidence in networking
