

We take pride in the fact that 70% of our program participants have successfully secured employment or engaged in employment related activities as a direct result of using this model.

uLaunch delivers NDIS Employment services, support coordination and core supports in remote communities in the Northern Territory and North Queensland.

We place a strong emphasis on tailoring the program to each individual's specific needs, with an ultimate goal of achieving positive outcomes in both employment, education and daily goals.






Pilot Program

Monday 9th of September marked a significant milestone for the Year 10, 11, and 12 students who participated in the Get Up and Goal program. Codesigned and co-delivered by uLaunch and the Purple Hands Foundation, this initiative saw a remarkable group of students from two schools graduate after 10 weeks of participation.

Throughout the program, these students explored pathways to employment, learned about work opportunities, and gained valuable insights into maintaining good physical and mental health. They developed essential skills such as interview preparation and workplace etiquette, all within a supportive environment that fostered choice and resilience.





Our Country Manager and MD, Mark Burns, had the honour of welcoming and congratulating the students on their progress. Following his inspiring words, the students were presented with certificates and enjoyed a special tour of the Dockers Headquarters.

Background

The Purple Hands Foundation was born out of the Freemantle Docker's desire to have an impact on disadvantaged youth. It is a not-for-profit foundation helping young people overcome barriers to unlock their true potential, instilling important life skills using the power of sport.

In 2023 AKG sponsored the Purple Hands Foundation:

- The Freemantle Dockers Sensory Room
- A pilot focusing on harnessing sport and community to make a positive impact on youth unemployment

Current Pilot is "Get up and Goal" which has a disability focus. The program development was funded by a donation from AKG to Purple Hands. Participant future funding provided through DES and NDIS supports.



NDIS Remote Update

The past six months have been a rollercoaster for our remote team in Katherine. We've been tirelessly working to spread awareness about NDIS and how we can assist the people in the remote community.

Our outreach efforts have been extensive. We've been travelling to the remote community, meeting with community member's and educating them about the life-changing benefits of the NDIS. It's been a challenging task, but we've remained steadfast in our mission.

Through our diligent work, we've managed to submit 27 NDIS Access Request forms, along with the necessary consent forms, to the authorities. This has been a significant achievement, as it means we've been able to help these individuals take the first crucial step towards accessing the NDIS.

And the results have been truly rewarding. Out of those 27 applications, we've been able to secure NDIS plans for nine participants. This is reflective of the impact we're making and the difference we're bringing to the lives of these individuals.

It's had its ups and downs, successes and setbacks. But through it all, our team has remained committed, driven and determined to make a lasting difference. We know that the work we're doing is vital, and we're not going to stop until we've reached every single person in this community who can benefit from the NDIS.

The road ahead may be long and winding, but with each NDIS plan we secure we're one step closer to our goal of empowering this community and transforming lives. This is what keeps us going, and this is what will continue to drive us forward.

Business Updates...

NDIS Price Guide Changes

Pricing Updates for 2024-2025: Changes in Pricing Arrangements and Limits

- 1. Short Notice Cancellations
- Non-DSW supports: 2 clear business days
- DSW supports: 7 clear business days
- Therapeutic Supports and Support Coordination revert to 2 clear business days
- 2. SLES Transitional Arrangements
- Eligible to claim using the support item for Employment Assistance starting from 01 July 2024.
- Can claim the current weekly rate until 30 June 2027 pending results of the blended payment trial.
- Anticipate that new plans will exclude SLES, replacing it with a budget for Employment Assistance.
- 3. Pricing
- Most prices have risen, with the temporary 1% loading removed.
- Most Therapy Supports remain unchanged, while Support Coordination levels 2 and 3 remain the same. Support Connection (and Psychosocial Recovery Coaching) rates have increased.
- Price caps for psychology and behavior supports have been raised.
- 4. TTP Discontinued
- Line items have been eliminated from the Support Catalogue.
- 5. Covid Loading Removed
- 1% has been removed from many Core items.
- 6. Plans Will Be Indexed
- All plans will be adjusted to reflect the new price caps, but only for supports with an increase.
- 7. PACE

No adjustments in the updated Pricing Arrangements to accommodate changes in Support Categories with PACE.
